CAMWS AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN COLLEGE TEACHING 2013-2014

This award recognizes outstanding teaching in Classics at colleges and universities within CAMWS territory. The winner of this award receives \$500. The nominee must be a member in good standing of CAMWS, teaching classical subjects full-time at a college or university.

The nomination deadline is **Friday, January 10, 2014**, and the deadline for all application materials is **Friday, January 31, 2014**.

Candidates should submit:

1. A current CV, typed, in 12-point font.
2. A maximum of three letters of support from administrators and/or peer colleagues. Letters must be typed, in 12-point font, and should not exceed two pages.
3. A maximum of three letters of support from students (preferably past students). Letters must be typed, in 12-point font, and should not exceed two pages.
4. A statement of teaching philosophy, typed, in 12-point font, not to exceed two pages.
