

Scansion, Sight, and Symbolism: Reading Ovid in the Intermediate Latin Classroom

This panel will feature best practices in teaching Ovid in the intermediate Latin classroom. Secondary-level Latin teachers will share teaching units for the tales of Daphne, Aeneas, and Arachne in the *Metamorphoses* as well as a variety of methods developed to help students read and interpret authentic Latin literature. Topics will include approaches to teaching scansion, using sight reading to assess reading comprehension, integrating Roman culture with the study of Latin literature, and introducing literary figures of speech. In addition, the panel will explore other pedagogical techniques including web quests, creative projects, and the development of student classroom leadership.
