CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE CAMWS FIRST BOOK AWARD

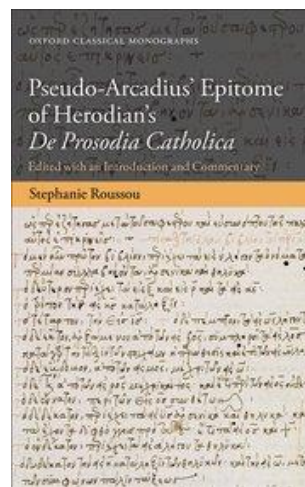
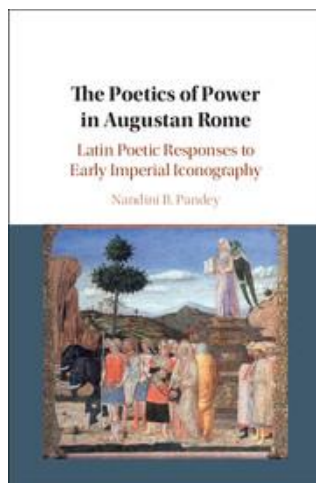
