



AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS

CAMWS AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN COLLEGE TEACHING

This award recognizes outstanding teaching in Classics at colleges and universities within CAMWS territory. The winner of this award receives \$500. Both full- and part-time teachers (who teach at least half-time with a minimum of five years teaching experience) are eligible for the award. The nominee must be a member in good standing of CAMWS.

The nomination and application process take place in the fall and awards are announced at the annual CAMWS business meeting.

Candidates should submit (typed, in 12pt font):

1. A current CV
2. A maximum of three letters of support from administrators and/or peer colleagues. Letters should not exceed two pages.
3. A maximum of three letters of support from students (preferably past students). Letters should not exceed two pages.
4. A statement of teaching philosophy, not to exceed two pages.
5. A high-resolution color photograph (jpg) for publicity purposes.
