NHA Lauds Latest Round of NEH Grants

WASHINGTON, D.C. – The National Humanities Alliance released the following statement today from its Executive Director Stephen Kidd on the December announcement of \$14.8 million in grants from the National Endowment for the Humanities to support 253 humanities projects nationwide:

“The latest round of grants underscores the National Endowment for the Humanities’s crucial role in preserving our nation’s cultural heritage, funding the work 56 state humanities councils, and supporting cutting-edge digital humanities projects. Collectively, NEH grants provide access to the humanities in every state and territory.

“The NEH’s investments generate public-private partnerships, cutting-edge research, promote teaching, and provide lifelong learning opportunities. They create jobs and community hubs in rural and urban areas alike. Both Republicans and Democrats in Congress have continued to affirm the value of these programs to their communities, having passed legislation to increase the funding of the NEH for the fourth consecutive year last Fall.

“We are immensely proud of the NEH’s impact across the U.S. and will continue advocating for increased federal support for future grants in 2019 and beyond.”
