### SCHOLARSHIP POLICIES

#### **FORUM GRANT**

1. The Roman Forum was more than a marketplace, it was a place of encounter, where all people of the Civitas would meet and exchange. “FORUM” is also the name of the Latin method textbook published by Polis Institute Press in 2017.

This grant is aimed to provide a full scholarship for a Polis graduate program student who can collaborate in the teaching of the Latin language in an immersive way while participating in the academic program.

#### 2. Requirements

a- All applicants should be students of an Academic Program at Polis Institute or have begun the application process for a program.

b- All applicants will be required to write an essay on a topic that they will receive from the office once the application form and other documents have been submitted.

c- Fluency in spoken Latin is required

#### 3. Grant Terms

a- Once the decision has been made, the students will receive a letter specifying if they have received the grant.

b- This scholarship will be given in the form of a tuition discount. 100% of tuition for a single academic year will be covered by this grant.

c- Students who receive this grant will be required to fulfill 20 hours of volunteer work per week during the academic year.

d- The recipient of the Scholarship will receive 1,000 New Israeli Shekel/month for 10 months.

e- This grant is subject to the General Requisites of the Grant Fund, which can be found on the application form and upon request from the Administrative Office.

4. These policies are in effect for the 2018-2019 academic year.
