INTERNATIONAL FIELD SCHOOL ON SITE FORMATION, STRATIGRAPHY, AND GEOARCHAEOLOGY IN THE ATHENIAN AGORA

The Malcolm H. Through field observations, laboratory analysis, and lectures, the students will receive instruction in the study and analysis of archaeological sediments and deposits, as well as gain experience in the recording of stratigraphy, and the understanding site formation processes.
