

*Magnas inter opes inops?* Finding Funding as a Graduate Student

With the rising cost of tuition, the shrinking coffers of humanities departments, and the increasing need to implement innovative and unique research strategies, graduate students are feeling the pressure to find as many sources of funding as possible. However, there are so many different forms of funding, ways to apply, and requirements to meet, that the entire process can seem daunting. In this presentation, I will speak from my experience as a recent PhD graduate who has received funding from private and public, as well as national and international sources. I will discuss not only where to look for funding, but how to write and organize your application materials. The goal is to make the entire process less intimidating and time consuming, so that you can focus on the real task at hand: writing your dissertation.
