

The 2019 College Greek Exam

This paper reports on the eleventh annual College Greek Exams (CGE), administered in Spring and Fall, 2019. It begins with a brief history of the exam and describes developments in recent years (e.g., the transition to being administered by CAMWS). Scores and averages for the 2019 exams are analyzed with respect to previous results. The results of the exams are then analyzed according to grammatical categories. Where the same or similar questions have been asked on previous exams, there is a comparison of how the students did on the question across the years. The report includes some general comments on how the exam and the results mesh with certain issues in teaching beginning and intermediate Greek at the college level, both pedagogical (textbooks, etc) and administrative (the need for external assessment tools, etc). Finally, the report provides updates on administering the exam in the wake of Covid and potential future initiatives.
